



Standardised Price List

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this pricelist for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors as these can vary.

Attended Funeral (funeral director's charges only)	£2195.00
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£ 835.00
Collecting and transporting the deceased from the place of death into the funeral directors care.	£ 180.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's premises.	£ 180.00
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be Oak Veneer as standard	£ 500.00
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends by appointment with the funeral director	£ 0.00
A date and time to be agreed with the funeral director for the service to be held at the crematorium and transport the deceased person in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£ 500.00
Unattended Funeral	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£1000.00
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee, Coffin,) ²	£1350.00
Fees you must pay	
For an attended or unattended burial funeral, the burial fee ¹	£473.00-£740.00
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for residents is:	£473.00-£740.00
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot, for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees	
For an attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee ²	£850.00
Please discuss any specific religious, belief-based and or cultural requirements that you have with the funeral director.	
Additional Funeral Director Costs

Embalming	£200.00
Additional Mileage	Price upon request
The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.	

¹This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for re-opening and closing an existing grave.

²In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
